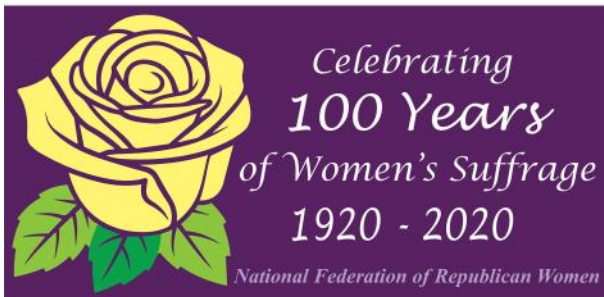

## Registering Voters is Critical to Victory in 2020!

*Are your friends and family all registered to vote? Here are several easy ways to get a voter registration card into their hands so they can get to the polls!*

### **TEXTING**

Have your family members, friends, or neighbor text "TXVOTE" to 72000 and they will be quickly and easily led through the process to receive a voter registration card right to their home. Follow up with them personally to make sure they mail in their card. We will follow up with the Secretary of State's office to make sure their registration was successful.

Feel free to distribute "Are you a Texan who is not yet registered to vote? Just text 'txvote' to 72000 and we'll help you get set up." (or some similar message) as much as you'd like – in your email signature, on your business card, on flyers, and anywhere else that you can spread the word.

### **BECOME A DEPUTY VOTER REGISTRAR**

Check with your county's Tax Assessor-Collector's office or web site to find a deputy voter registrar training session near you. Completing that training authorizes you to collect completed registration cards from new voters. Once you become deputized, work with others in your area to organize voter drives at your church, in your neighborhood, or in coordination with a community event.

### **TEXASGOP**

This link is a good alternative to use in your email signature with a message like: "Are you a Texan who is not yet registered to vote? Just complete the form at [texasgop.org/register-vote](https://texasgop.org/register-vote) and we'll help you get set up." Again, feel free to spread that as much as you'd like – in your email signature, on flyers, and anywhere else that you can spread the word.

## Van Taylor; Joe Neguse Introduce Bipartisan Bill to Establish Strategic National Stockpile Oversight Commission

Commission Would Report to Congress Outlining Measures Taken to Properly Maintain Levels of Emergency Supplies

Congressman Van Taylor (R-TX-03) said, "COVID-19 has presented an unprecedented threat and has impacted every facet of life as we know it." He continued, "We are facing serious disruptions to our pharmaceutical and medical supply chains and while we continue to increase domestic production efforts to combat this pandemic, it's imperative we understand and learn from the current situation. By creating this bipartisan commission, we can help ensure the Strategic National Stockpile contains the supplies and resources needed by federal, state, and local governments in times of crisis and improve our nation's ability to prepare for future national emergencies."

"The COVID-19 pandemic sweeping our nation has exposed the shortcomings of the Strategic National Stockpile to adequately provide states and localities across our nation with critical personal protective equipment, ventilators, and other desperately needed supplies," said Congressman Joe Neguse (D-CO-02). "In light of these shortcomings, we must have dedicated oversight and forward looking assessments of this vital inventory to ensure that we will never again be unprepared to react to any emergency situation we encounter."



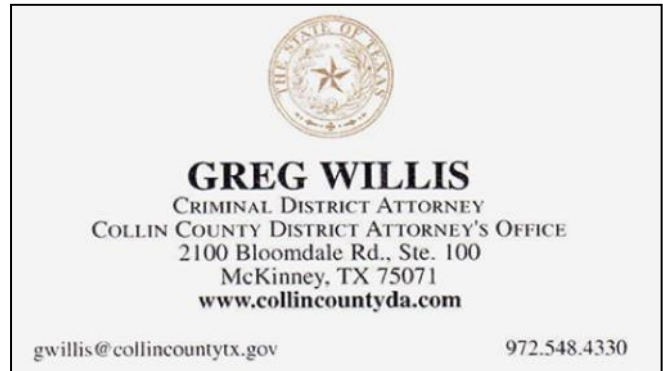
